JOB COAL: To provide safe and efficient transportation so that students may enjoy the fullest possible advantage from the district's curriculum and extracurricular program.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Obeys all traffic laws.
- 2. Observes all mandatory safety regulations for school buses.
- 3. Maintains discipline when students are on bus using district approved discipline plan.
- 4. Reports undisciplined students to the proper authority.
- 5. Keeps assigned bus clean.
- 6. Keeps to assigned schedule.
- 7. Checks bus before each operation for mechanical defects.
- 8. Discharges students only at authorized stops.
- 9. Exercises responsible leadership when on out-of-district school trips.
- 10. Transports only authorized students.
- 11. Reports all accidents and completes required reports.
- 12. Enforces regulations against smoking and eating on the bus.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: Salary and work year to be established by the Board.
