

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF CREVE COEUR SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 76, HELD AT LITCHFIELD BUILDING, 400 N. HIGHLAND, CREVE COEUR, ILLINOIS, ON JANUARY 31, 2023

President Bailey called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Answering roll call were Randy Giddens, Brenda Keogel, Amber Pilkington, Valerie Ragon, Samantha Severns, Pam Greiner, and Linda Bailey. Absent was none. Also present were Superintendent Johnson and Jacob Yocum.

Executive Session

Mrs. Ragon, seconded by Mrs. Keogel, made the motion to enter into executive session for Student Disciplinary Hearing at 6:02 p.m. ROLL CALL VOTE Yeas were Giddens, Keogel, Pilkington, Ragon, Severns, Greiner and Bailey. Nays were none. Motion carried.

Resume Regular Session

Mrs. Ragon, seconded by Mrs. Pilkington, made the motion to resume regular session at 6:55 p.m. ROLL CALL VOTE- Yeas were Giddens, Keogel, Pilkington, Ragon, Severns, Greiner and Bailey. Nays were none. Motion carried.

Mrs. Greiner, seconded by Mrs. Keogel, made the motion that the Board of Education of Creve Coeur District No. 76 finds that Student No. 22-04 was guilty of gross misconduct as set forth in the Illinois School Code and in violation of School Board policies; it is further determined that Student No. 22-04 be and is hereby expelled from Creve Coeur School District No. 76, for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year. ROLL CALL VOTE Yeas were Giddens, Keogel, Pilkington, Ragon, Severns, Greiner and Bailey. Nays were none. Motion carried.

Mrs. Greiner, seconded by Mrs. Keogel, made the motion that the expulsion of Student No. 22-04 be held in abeyance to allow Student 22-04 to be administratively transferred to the Tazewell County Regional Save School on February 1, 2023. Student 22-04 will be allowed to return to Parkview for the 2023-2024 school year and placed on a probationary status for the remainder of the 2023-2024 school year. Any suspendable offense shall require the student to appear before the Board of Education for review of the expulsion. ROLL CALL VOTE Yeas were Giddens, Keogel, Pilkington, Ragon, Severns, Greiner and Bailey. Nays were none. Motion carried.
