Ragon, made the motion that the expulsion of Student No. 17-01 be held in abeyance to allow Student No. 17-01 to return to LaSalle School on April 3, 2017 and Student No. 17-01 will be placed on a probationary status for the remainder of the 2016-2017 school year, any suspendable offense shall require Student No. 17-01 to appear before the Board of Education for review of the expulsion and possible further disciplinary consequences.
