- Time expectations for assignments and grades to be updated on SKYWARD
- Various ways to chart student discipline within the classrooms
- Lunchtime detentions vs after school detentions
- Alternative learning environments for both buildings and what it should consist of
- Ways to promote and use the Accelerated Reader program
- Setting up a committee to select a new ELA curriculum district wide for 2018-2019
- Setting up a district wide Google calendar to avoid scheduling conflicts
- How students are selected to receive RTI
- Allowing teachers to visit other schools as part of their professional development
- Positive incentives for employees
- Playground equipment remaining at Homewood Heights
- The need for all correspondence to parents be approved by the building principals
- Banning certain apparel due to safety issues
- Extra-Curricular concessions, uniforms and fundraisers
