

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF CREVE COEUR SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 76, HELD AT LITCHFIELD BUILDING, 400 N. HIGHLAND ROAD, CREVE COEUR, ILLINOIS, ON SEPTEMBER 6, 2022

Closed Session

Mrs. Ragon, seconded by Mrs. Greiner, made the motion to enter into executive session for Student Disciplinary Hearing at 6:01 p.m.

ROLL CALL VOTE Yeas were Giddens, Keogel, Ragon, Severns, Greiner and Bailey. Nays were none. Motion carried.

Resume Regular Session

Mrs. Bailey, seconded by Mrs. Keogel, made the motion to resume regular session at 8:47 p.m. ROLL CALL VOTE-Yeas were Giddens, Keogel, Ragon, Severns, Greiner and Bailey. Nays were none. Motion carried.

Mrs. Greiner, seconded by Mrs. Keogel, made the motion that the Board of Education of Creve Coeur District No. 76 finds that Student A was guilty of gross misconduct as set forth in the Illinois School Code and in violation of School Board policies; it is further determined that Student A be and is hereby expelled from Creve Coeur School District No. 76, for the remainder of the 1st semester of the 2022-2023 school year and further move that the expulsion of Student A be held in abeyance to allow Student A to be administratively transferred to the Tazewell County Regional Safe School on or about September 12, 2022 and Student A will be allowed to return to Parkview School on January 3, 2023 and will be placed on a probationary status for the remainder of the 2022-2023 school year. Any suspendable offense shall require the student to appear before the Board of Education for review of the expulsion.
