Ragon, made the motion that the Board of Education of Creve Coeur School District No. 76 finds that Student No. 21-02 was guilty of gross misconduct, as set forth in the Illinois School Code and in violation of School Board policies; it is further determined that Student No. 21-02 be and is hereby expelled from Creve Coeur School District No. 76, until the beginning of the 4th quarter on Monday, March 7, 2022. Mrs. Greiner, seconded by Mrs. Keogel, made the motion that the expulsion of Student No. 21-02 be held in abeyance to allow Student No. 21-02 to be administratively transferred to the Tazewell County Regional Safe School on October 18, 2021 and Student No. 21-02 will be placed on a probationary status for the remainder of the 2021-2022 school year, any suspendable offense shall require the student to appear before the Board of Education for review of the expulsion.
