

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF CREVE COEUR SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 76, HELD AT LITCHFIELD BUILDING, 400 N. HIGHLAND, CREVE COEUR, ILLINOIS, ON December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023**

ROLL CALL VOTE Yeas were Keogel, Ragon, Shear, Stimeling, Greiner and Bailey. Nays were none. Motion carried.

Mrs. Greiner, seconded by Mrs. Keogel, made the motion that the expulsion of Student No. 23-12 be held in abeyance to allow Student No. 23-12 to be administratively transferred to the Tazewell County Regional Safe School as determined and Student No. 23-12 well be placed on a probationary status for the 2023-2024 school year, any suspendable offence shall require the student to appear before the Board of Education for review of the expulsion.
