

# Reminder of Upcoming Election

## Board of Education

### Creve Coeur District #76

Creve Coeur District #76 will have four seats for the Board of Education on the ballot in the April 4, 2023 consolidated election. There are 3 four-year terms and 1 two-year term.

To be eligible to serve as a school board member, a candidate must be:

- A United States citizen;
- A resident of the state of Illinois and of the school district for at least one-year preceding appointment;
- At least 18 years of age;
- A registered voter; and
- Not a school trustee.

A school board member cannot be employed by the district (employment contracts worth more than \$1,000) or have any interest directly or indirectly in any contract, work, or business of the school district or in the sale of any article to the school district. Lastly, a school board member cannot be a child sex offender as defined in Section 11-9.3 of the Criminal Code, or convicted of an “infamous crime.”

To become a school board candidate, one must:

1. File a Statement of economic Interests with the Tazewell County Clerk and obtain a receipt.
2. Obtain and complete a nominating petition signed by at least 50 registered voters and a Statement of Candidacy. The submitted petition will require a notarized signature of petition circulator.

**Filing Dates are December 12<sup>th</sup> through the 19<sup>th</sup>.**

Regular meetings of the Board of Education are held on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month. Committee meetings and Special Meetings are held as necessary. This is a volunteer position and no salary is involved.
