COMMUNICATION

As a parent, you may on occasion have a concern regarding what your child communicates to you about the events of the school day.



When you have these concerns, be a good listener to your child and ask questions. Your first contact with the school needs to be directly to

your child's teacher: Give them a telephone call, send an email, message them on Dojo, or write a note to schedule a personal conference. It is often surprising what you may discover after speaking to the teacher. Children often view things differently than adults, or leave out important details. We have a great, professional staff at LaSalle School. Please be respectful and courteous by going to them first to help resolve your concerns.



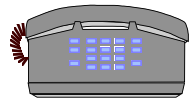
BOOK FEES REMINDER

If you signed a textbook and materials fee compliance form during registration, please be aware that payment is due by October 1st. Please call Ms. Davis at 698-3604 if you have any questions regarding approvals or qualification.



ABSENTEE LINE

If your child is not able to attend school because of illness, please call 698-3605, extension 1, the absentee line, before 8:00 a.m. Please leave a detailed message as to why they are absent. The answering machine is available 24 hours a day.



REMEMBER, if you message the teacher directly you will **still need to contact the office** as to why your child is not at school.

LATE SCHOOL ARRIVAL

Classes start at 8:30 a.m. Students who arrive after 8:30 are considered late.

A parent or responsible party **must bring** the child into the building **and sign** them in, if tardy. They must have a pass to enter the classroom if they are tardy.

Every school day, we have a child who either loses a book bag, jacket, or lunch box. Please be sure to label with your child's name all items brought to school.



TRANSPORTATION HOME

We try to be sensitive and responsive to your desires, especially when family emergencies occur, we must reinforce that parents must send written notes (with parent signatures) whenever your child is to leave school early or their transportation arrangements for the day changes ie: from bus to parent pick up or you may use the Dojo app to communicate with your child's teacher. **Without a note or message on the Dojo app your child will be sent home using his/her regular dismissal procedure. We are not allowed to give out one day bus passes to a student. Parent phone calls after 11:00 a.m. will not be honored except in extreme emergencies.** If you have any questions regarding the transportation policies you may call the district office at 698-3600. Your cooperation is much appreciated.



LATCHKEY PARENT PICK-UP

To avoid any further confusion for our students and parents, Latchkey parents must use the doors at the front office, door 1. You will need to phone latchkey directly and they will bring your child to you and you will need to sign them out.. The office will not be allowed to get your child for you. Latchkey parent pick up time is between 3:30-3:40 p.m. Latchkey is a service we receive from the Tazewell County Health Department. All inquiries about this policy should be handled by either the site coordinator or the TCHD.



BOOK-IT! PROGRAM

Book-It! is a reading incentive program sponsored by Pizza Hut. It is a very successful program that will begin on October 1st. Your child's teacher will have specific details for their grade level.



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MEDICAL REMINDER



Physical exams and immunization records are required by law when entering Kindergarten. In addition, a Certificate of Live Birth must be provided for Kindergarten and new students. These are available at the County Courthouse, where your child was born, for a fee. Upon entering a public school for the first time an eye exam is also required. All medical is due by October 15th. Medical reminders will be mailed home in the next two weeks. If you have not already turned the required papers into the office, please do so immediately.
