## **Food Establishment Inspection Report- LaSalle Elementary School**

The Tazewell County Health Department provided a routine inspection of the Food Service Program provided for our students enrolled at LaSalle Elementary School.

The report indicated (0) risk factors or intervention violations.

### **Internet Safety Program**

Brad Ware, Community Outreach Specialist (Federal Bureau of Investigation), in previous years spoke to students in grades 5 – 8 on the topic of Internet Safety. Brad Ware has recently retired. We are currently working with the FBI Office in Springfield to check on scheduling a similar program with our students in the upcoming year. The Springfield FBI Office is going to reach out to the Peoria FBI Office to see if an Agent could provide the presentation for our students.

### **TMCSEA Committee Meeting**

Representatives of Districts who belong to the Tazewell-Mason Counties Special Education Cooperative recently met at a meeting held at Schramm School. Information presented included:

#### **FY22 Medicaid Cost Settlement**

- On June 27, 2024, the Illinois Department of Health and Family Services released Cost Settlement payments for Fiscal Year 2022, via the IL Comptroller's Office.
- Tazewell - Mason Special Education Cooperative received the Medicaid Cost Settlement payments for Fiscal Year 2022 in the amount of \$ 301,237.49. Since this reimbursement reflects Medicaid Fee for Service Revenue, these \$'s will be returned to the member districts. The \$'s will be returned to the local districts based on calculations that reflect the school-based medical services provided to member district students by the Coop.

**ISBE Cyclical Monitoring Cohort Placement**

ISBE's new cyclical monitoring process regarding special education services offered in school districts starts this school year. Every district has been assigned to one of six cohorts in Illinois.

Creve Coeur School District # 76 has been placed in Cohort 2 along with (4) districts in the Coop. This process will commence in the 2025-2026 school year.
