<u>Ameren Illinois / Natural Gas Pipeline Update:</u> Dawn Bauer, ORC-Real Estate Solutions for Infrastructure provided the following update: July 21, 2022:

- Ameren has completed the process of laying the pipe and covering the pipe.
- Ameren has initiated the cleanup and restoration. Grass seed is being planted and covered with straw.

The project is nearing completion.

<u>Building & Grounds Update:</u> Russ Garey has been working hard on the Baseball Field at Parkview School. The infield has been dragged. The Village helped with cutting the weeds on field entry road. Finally, the bleachers and benches inside the dugouts are being painted. The baseball field will be ready for the 1st softball and baseball practice.

Re-Roof Project: Union Contractor Group returned to the work site on Tuesday, July 5 to continue with the re-roof project at LaSalle Elementary School. Union Contractor Group has completed the roofing membrane work. Union Contractor Group still has sheet metal work to complete. The Project Manager communicated that sheet metal work should be completed by Friday, July 29. Jim Hollenback, PCM & Design Architects, communicated that he will inspect the project at the project's conclusion to be certain that the job was completed properly.

LaSalle Elementary School Curb, Sidewalk & Drain Project: Aupperle Construction is on site completing the work on the curb, sidewalk & drain project at LaSalle Elementary School. Substantial completion of demolition has occurred. More demolition is expected to occur today along with framing to follow. Concrete is anticipated being poured on Thursday, August 28. The project is expected to be completed by the end of the work day, Friday, August 29. Weather permitting.

LaSalle Elementary Parking Lot Sealing / Striping Project: City Coal & Asphalt is planning on completing the LaSalle Elementary Parking Lot Sealing / Striping Project during the week of August 1 through August 5. The sealing of the drive at the Litchfield Building is expected to begin on Wednesday, July 27. Weather permitting.

<u>Lift Used at Parkview School – LaSalle Elementary School:</u> A lift was recently used in the Gym at Parkview School for cleaning purposes. Some of the lighting was replaced as some of the bulbs were burned out. The lift was used in the Cafeteria at LaSalle Elementary School to provide assistance with taking down the supports used for the basketball goals in the Cafeteria.

<u>Basketball Backboard Repaired – Playground- Parkview School:</u> Mr. Thompson and Matt Ragon repaired the basketball backboard on the playground at Parkview School. The backboard had been damaged during the past school year.

<u>Water Heater Installation – Basement – LaSalle Elementary School:</u> Matt Ragon recently installed a new water heater in the basement at LaSalle Elementary School. The water heater being replaced was corroding in a significant manner.

<u>Cleaning of Gym Floor:</u> Allred Floor Service has completed the cleaning and refinishing of the Gym Floor at Parkview School.

<u>LaSalle Elementary School – Sprinkler Head Replacement Project</u>: The PIPCO Companies, Ltd. communicated that the Sprinkler Head Replacement Project will occur on Saturday, August 6 in LaSalle Elementary School.

Transportation Matter: We were apprised that due to supply & demand issues, parts, etc. ...the new bus (Lease) that was approved by the Board that we expected to receive prior to August 12 will most likely not be ready until November or December. I asked the sales representative if a loaner could be provided at no cost to the District until the new bus arrives. The sales representative communicated that he thought this could occur. The loaner bus would be 3 years of age. We would be responsible for providing insurance coverage for the loaner. If we do not secure the loaner....we would be operating 4 routes with 4 buses without a backup in the event we had mechanical issues with 1 of the buses. We have communicated with the sales representative of the District's desire of securing a loaner until the new bus arrives.

<u>2022-2023 Registration:</u> Student Registration is being offered in an "online" manner effective July 26 through August 2. In-Person Registration will also be offered on Tuesday, August 2 from 1:00 PM – 7:00 PM at Parkview School. With an Online Registration being offered, parents and guardians will need access to their login to Skyward Family Access to register their child or children. Early reports indicate that the "online" portion of Registration is going well.
