School Choice

Illinois School Code requires school choice for students enrolled in a school that is failing to meet annual yearly progress.

Sec. 10-21.3a. Transfer of students. (a) Each school board shall establish and implement a policy governing the transfer of a student from one attendance center to another within the school district upon the request of the student's parent or guardian. Any request by a parent or guardian to transfer his or her child from one attendance center to another within the school district pursuant to Section 1116 of the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. Sec. 6317) must be made no later than 30 days after the parent or guardian receives notice of the right to transfer pursuant to that law.

There are no schools within the District where an eligible student can transfer and no area schools are accepting the students from our District.
